

SPIRIT WEEK

Dear Parents and Students,

St. Anthony School will hold our annual Spirit Week celebration the week of March 27-31, 2017. All St. Anthony students are invited to participate. Our schedule will be as follows:

Monday— Crazy Hat Day

Students may wear their funniest, strangest, just plain craziest hats with their **school uniforms**. They should keep in mind that they **cannot** wear the hats to Church (students will leave them in the classroom during Mass).

Tuesday— Twins Day

Students may dress like each other (they can also be a “triplet,” etc.). The “twins” do not have to be in the same grade, but they must be able to identify their “twin.” Those who dress as a “twin” may wear jeans, but they must be the same color jeans, and their shirts should match.

Wednesday—Comfortable Day

Students may wear their favorite sweatshirt or hoodie today with jeans or sweatpants. All clothing **must** be school-appropriate. Hoods may not be on the head during the school day.

Thursday—Sports Day

Students may wear jeans with the t-shirt, sweatshirt, or jersey of their favorite sports team—St. Anthony, high school, college, or professional team.

Students may wear any **school appropriate** clothing that is crazy. *This does **not** include pajamas or flannel pajama-style pants.* For example, they could wear plaid pants and a striped shirt. They may also wear their hair in a wild and crazy hairstyle. However, **NO** hair coloring or dye may be used.
