### Junior High Privileges

The following uniform privileges are for students in grades 6-8:

- Natural looking chemically colored hair girls only
- Light natural looking makeup worn by girls only
- Natural looking (earthy: beige, nude, soft pink, French manicured, etc.) colored nail polish worn by girls only;  
NO FAKE/PRESS-ON NAILS!

St. Anthony School permits students to dress up/dress down on specific days. St. Anthony School expects students to dress in a professional and modest manner. Jewelry, makeup, and nail polish rules still apply. Students deemed by administration to not be in compliance will be given a school uniform to wear.

## **Dress Up Days**

The following items are considered appropriate for dress up days:

Girls:

- Dress slacks / capri dress pants
- Dress shirts with collars
- Sweaters are permitted (NOT SWEATSHIRTS!)
- Sandals must have a strap behind the heel
- Dresses or skirts no more than two (2) inches above the knee in the front **and** the back
- Leggings permitted **provided the skirt/dress being worn is the appropriate length.**

Boys:

- Dress pants
- Dress shirts with collars
- Sweaters are permitted (NOT SWEATSHIRTS!)
- Uniform style shorts (Not allowed 10/1 through 4/30 unless otherwise noted)

Items NOT considered appropriate:

- Jeans
- Athletic shoes
- Tank tops or t-shirts
- Bottoms must not be too tight or too loose
- Dresses or shirts with spaghetti straps or made of sheer material
- Flip flops (shoes made of foam) including flip flops with a strap
- Strapless tops (even covered with sweater or jacket) are not permitted

## **Dress Down Days**

The following items are considered appropriate for dress down days:

- Jeans (no rips, no "jeggings"), cargo, capri, jogger pants
- Shorts no more than four (4) inches above the knee (Not allowed 10/1 through 4/30 unless otherwise noted)
- Sweatshirts or t-shirts with appropriate printing

Items NOT considered appropriate:

- Leggings
- Tank tops
- Pajamas of any kind
- Strapless or spaghetti strap dresses
- Flip flops (shoes made of foam) including flip flops with a strap
- Strapless tops (even covered with sweater or jacket) are not permitted
