Educational Leadership----Mr. Alarcon update :

- Playground contract signed by our lawyer, and as of 4:00pm today, we have a Project Manager assigned through the Playground Company (Mike Massey). Signing the contract, providing a down payment, and assigning the project manager are part of the ordering process, so as soon as Mr. Massey touches base with Mr. Alarcon, we will better know the lead time on the equip. and schedule the install. Shooting for Aug. Fencing is not included with the install.
- -Title IV School Grant funds (>\$18,000) to be used to offset the cost of educational related field trips-Wash. D.C. for 8th graders; Columbus day trip for 7th gr; Put in Bay for 6th gr.
- -Mask policy per Mr. Alarcon's newsletters. Masks mandate lifted as of Feb. 22
- -Ms. Tabor hired as sub Thurs and Fri.
- -Mrs. Katrisak filling in daily for Art and Music until another teacher is found since Mrs. Rentz is no longer employed by the school.
- -Another Aide hired with ESC \$\$ for M-W-Fri-Mrs. Doudell
- -Mrs. Burge is writing a grant for St. Anthony to have a Summer School Program aimed at young elementary school aged children
- -How is the grant money being used for STEM and the Science Room?? Nothing started yet. Staff enrichment to help build worthwhile programs and utilize technology already in the school as well
 - -Enrollment is improved for next year with K, 2nd, 4th and 6th capped out.
