EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP----Mr. Alarcon-----7th gr trip to Columbus and 8th gr DC trip were a success and fun was had by all; 6th gr trip rescheduled for May 23; Second gr trip tomorrow; the goal next school year is to have classroom field trips more often, rolling over the unused PAC funds from this year to next along with Title \$\$. Mr. Alarcon will determine amount of Title \$\$ he has to work with by the August meeting.

Summer Fun Camp Program scheduled for Pre-1st graders the last week of May through mid June spearheaded by Mrs. Burge who also wrote the grant for the program-more info to come for those interested; EANS has given the school \$800,000 funding over the next 3 years with specific usage for the \$\$ needing to be approved through Lorain Educational Services. We are hoping to purchase a book vending machine, projectors for the classrooms, touchscreen TV's which are rolling smartboards, keep the instructional aides we have now plus add more for the middle school and 1st gr.; Social Emotional Learning investment—teachers, and admin becoming more knowledgeable about the benefit of this approach through increasing our school psychologists days in the building leading small groups; discussion re: how to bring the Catholic back to St. Anthony—hoping to have more traditions return through the help of our PCL; no more Pre-K grad—back to K grad. 8th grade grad event the last week of May starting with Monday all school mass honoring them with Mrs. Obermiller taking the lead on this; playground building date not secured- Diana to be point person for playground project manager through summer.
