# St. Anthony of Padua Parish School of Religion 2023-2024 Guidelines

## **Attendance:**

**PSR Classes are held Mondays from 6:15-7:30 pm**. Regular attendance is expected of all students. *Please notify us if your child is unable to attend*. You can email <a href="mailto:psr@stanthonylorain.com">psr@stanthonylorain.com</a>. If your child is not present and you have not notified us, we will contact you - so that both parents and teachers know the whereabouts of the child.

If a child misses too many classes, which hinders his or her religious education, the parent will be notified and, if necessary, the child will be asked to repeat the grade. In order to get the full benefit of the class, please have your child to class on time. *Doors will open at 6:00 pm.* **Students must attend PSR to participate in CYO sports.** Students who stop attending PSR as soon as their CYO sports programs are finished will be ineligible to participate in the following year.

For the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation, your child should have had regular and continuous religious instruction from grade 2 through grade 8.

# If you are sick:

We ask that you please stay home if you have a temperature of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or higher or if you have <u>any</u> illness symptoms. Please email <u>psr@stanthonylorain.com</u> so we know not to expect you.

# **Entrance/Exit Procedures:**

Door will open at 6:00 pm for students to arrive. Students will enter and exit through the same propped door and immediately enter their classroom.

#### Masks:

We will follow the protocol set forth by the Lorain Health Department.

## **Health & Safety Protocols:**

The building and classrooms will be cleaned and sanitized.

Social Distancing of 6 feet will be implemented in the classrooms and hallways.

Hand sanitizer will be available in the classrooms, as well, as built in time for hand washing. Do not bring anything with you to class. All students will have the supplies they need in the classroom.

## **Emergency Form and Record Updates:**

Emergency phone numbers must be on file. Please notify us by the email above of any corrections or changes to phone numbers, address or names.

## **Inclement Weather:**

We will **NOT** hold PSR classes if:

- 1. Lorain City Schools cancels or cuts short due to bad weather conditions.
- 2. Lorain City Schools cancels their evening activities.
- 3. St. Anthony Day School has to close on its own.

If bad weather conditions occur later in the day, and it is necessary to cancel PSR classes, you will be notified via **email & remind text message to your information on file.** 

# **Discipline:**

- *Dress Code:* Please follow your school's dress code. The following are not allowed: bare midriffs or sloppy clothing, tank tops, T-shirts with offensive messages or pictures, & sagging pants or visible underwear. Do wear sturdy, safe shoes. **NO flip flops.**
- Respect is to be demonstrated toward faculty, volunteers and fellow students at all times.
- Active participation in all classroom activities with no attempt to disrupt the class.
- School property and equipment are to be properly cared for.
- Cooperation with policies regarding safety including fire drills and tornado drills.

We ask that you child(ren) not bring anything with them to class. We will supply all the needed items. Objects of distraction such as electronic games, chewing gum and cell phones are not part of the learning process. The teacher will take items of distraction and hold until after class if needed. If your child carries a cell phone, please have it turned off or silenced during class.
