

#### MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

#### **Prayer for Ordering One's Life**

Grant to me, O merciful God, that I may ardently desire, prudently seek out, truly discern, and perfectly fulfill all that is pleasing to thee, to the praise and glory of thy Name.

Order, O my God, my state in life, that I may know what you would have me do; and that I may follow to the end that which is best and expedient for my soul.

Grant to me, O Lord my God, that I may not falter in the midst of prosperity or adversity, that in the one I may not be puffed up, and in the other I may not be deflated. May nothing cause me joy or sorrow, except what leads me towards thee or takes me away from thee. May I desire to please no one, and fear to displease no one, except thee.

May all that is transitory, O Lord, become worthless to me, and all that is eternal, dear to me. May joys that are without thee weary me, and may I long for nothing besides thee. May work that is for thee, Lord, delight me; and may any rest, which is without thee, be tedious to me.

Grant, my God, that my heart be directed towards thee, and to sorrow unceasingly for my despondency, while resolving to amend my way of life.

Give to me, Lord God, a vigilant heart, which by no curiosity is taken away in thought from thee: a noble heart, which by no unworthy affection is dragged downward: an upright heart, which by no sinister intention is led astray: a firm heart, which by no tribulation is crushed: a liberated heart, which by no violent affection is enslaved.

Give bountifully to me, O Lord my God, understanding to know thee, diligence in seeking thee, wisdom in finding thee, behavior that is pleasing to thee, confident perseverance in expecting thee, and firm trust to the end in clasping on to thee. Grant that your punishments here I may suffer through penance, that your gifts on earth I may utilize through grace, that your joys in heaven I may reap through glory: Who lives and reigns, God, forever and ever. 




#### ADORATION CHAPEL


St. Simeon the prophet lived a holy life and longed to behold the Messiah. St. Anna also awaited His coming, praying day and night in the temple. Imagine their joy when Mary and Joseph brought the baby Jesus to the temple. Simeon's prayer is said every day worldwide in night prayer:

"Now, Master, You may let your servant go in peace according to Your word for my eyes have seen Your salvation which You prepared in sight of all the peoples, light for revelation to the Gentiles and glory for Your people Israel." (Luke 2:29-32)

"Fr. Paul Miki was the son of an affluent Japanese military chief and a gifted evangelist who strongly defended the faith against Buddhism. When the political climate became hostile in Japan, the missionaries decided to continue their ministry in secret. The Jesuits did not want to leave the faithful without the Holy Eucharist and sacraments. They were eventually arrested. Fr. Miki was martyred along with 2 other Jesuits and 23 other Christians united in a common faith and love for Jesus Christ and His Church."
