## A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR EASTER SUNDAY

Happy Easter! In some parts of the world, people give this greeting: “Christ is risen!” and the response is, “Yes, he is truly risen!” My prayer is that whatever is happening in your life, whatever is going on in your family – that today you will feel the joy of Christ’s resurrection. As we said in the Psalm of the Easter Mass, **“This is the day that Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad.”**

My friends, God wants us to have joy. He gave us a world that is good and beautiful. And when we made a mess of his creation with sin, war, disease, etc., he gave us a new creation – in Christ. We have every reason to rejoice. The devil wants to rob us of our joy. He does it in a deceptive way. He offers things like alcohol, drugs, power, pleasure, egoism, pride, and many more worldly enticements. God, on the other hand, offers joy that endures.

The first step to joy is forgiveness. In fact, St. Peter spoke of this often. As leader of that small group of Christians, he gave the first Easter homily. It’s still the best one ever given. Peter tells how Christ died for our sins. And Peter should know, because he committed one of the greatest sins – denying that he even knew Jesus. But Peter did not sink into despair; he didn’t shift the blame. No, he accepted forgiveness. He concludes with these words, **“Everyone who believes in him will receive forgiveness of sins through his name.”**

Yes, the reality of the cross will still be there in our lives. In fact, Jesus has told us we have to take up our cross daily, follow him, and be his disciple. However, we are never left to bear our crosses alone. Like St. Peter, we will know the strength that comes from joy. **Christ is risen! Yes, he is truly risen! Amen. I pray that you will have a Blessed Easter filled with Hope and Joy.**

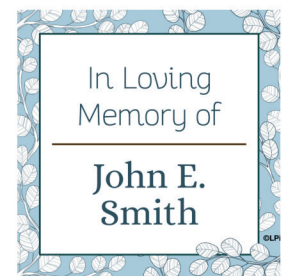
